FUNERAL RITES FOR MISS PRATT

One of Oldest Residents Of Manchester Passes; Services Sunday

MANCHESTER -- Funeral services for Miss Harriet M. Pratt, 85, one of the oldest residents of Manchester, who died in Thompson Memorial Hospital, Canandaigua, Friday, will be held from the home in Howard Street Sunday at 2:30. Interment will be in Manchester Cemetery.

Miss Pratt was the daughter of Merrick and Sarah Wolvin Pratt. She was a graduate of Brockport Normal School and entered the teaching profession at the age of 17. She was one of the oldest of four living members of the Methodist Church, and was secretary of the Foreign Missionary Society for many years.

Devoted to civic affairs, Miss Pratt gave the village sufficient land for a right of way in Howard Street. The municipal park site was donated to the village by her grandfather, Ebenezer Pratt.

Survivors are one sister, Mrs. J. E. Fish, of Manchester; seven nieces and four nephews.
