MRS. LIBBIE BLAKE

At the home of her daughter, Mrs. Charles Harris, in Fairport, on Saturday, March 1, 1930, occurred the death of Mrs. Libbie Blake.

Elizabeth Dilts was born in Livonia on July 19, 1845, where she lived until her marriage to Hector W. Blake, of Naples, on October 24, 1878. They came to Naples in 1889, residing here until their removal to Rochester twenty years ago. Mr. Blake died in June, 1910. Two or three years later Mrs. Blake took up her residence with her daughter. Besides the daughter, she is survived by two nephews, Charles Deiffenbacher and Frank Dilts, both of Rochester, and by several other nephews and nieces.

The body was brought to Naples and funeral services were conducted on Monday afternoon from the home of her brother-in-law, A. M. Blake, by Rev. William Partington, pastor of the local Methodist Church. Burial was made in Rose Ridge cemetery by the side of her husband.

Mrs. Blake was a very capable woman, interested at all times in the welfare of the community in which she lived. She was a member of the Naples Methodist Church and a charter member of the W. F. M. S.
